

Bainbridge Island City Hall

At the planning stage, CDC developed a downtown urban design plan for the community of Bainbridge Island, that addressed the location of a new city hall, in the heart of the community, just off the town's main retail street.

In the building design phase, the plan includes a two story building featuring a parking area and two green plazas interconnected by a pedestrian street. The design of the various site spaces tie the building to the street and to the adjacent businesses. CDC collaborated with the architect to maintain the community oriented design features.

CDC worked with two local artists in the final design stages to incorporate art elements in the concrete walkways and walls surrounding the building.
